Question (should be worded so that it can be answered with either "Yes" or "No"):

Can a combustible egress ramp be terminated at 30" AFF and continued (same ramp) with a NON combustible ramp structure to levels above 30" AFF.

Answer:

No.

The basis for the reply as offered is that once a ramp crosses the 30" threshold the entire ramp needs to meet the more restrictive requirements of the non-combustible construction type.
