As per Florida Fire Prevention Code (2007) NFPA 101 Section 7.3.1, when calculating the occupant load for a 37,000 GSF Business Occupancy, is it correct (yes or no) to exclude typically non-habitable spaces (hallways, restrooms, mechanical rooms, stairways, etc.) and use the occupant load of 100 GSF/person for all remaining areas, including conference rooms, meeting rooms, and break rooms?
